#### Dear Students,

Recently, we have received reports of unauthorized salesman entering the campus to promote and sell graduation trips (Ex: to Thailand). We urge everyone to stay vigilant and help reinforce awareness to prevent unauthorized sales and potential fraud on campus.

#### 1. Prohibition of Unauthorized Sales Activities

- All commercial sales activities without approval are strictly prohibited on campus, including but not limited to multi-level marketing, credit card promotions, loan consultations, and product trials.
- Do not accept products or services from unknown individuals, as this may lead to being misled into signing unfair contracts.

## 2. Be Aware of Fraudulent Tactics and Strengthen Personal Protection

### (1) Common Types of Scams:

- 1. Impersonation of School or Institutions Fraudsters may claim to be school representatives, requesting personal information or payments.
- 2. Investment Scams Promises of high returns to lure students into fraudulent investment schemes.
- 3. Shopping Scams Selling low-priced items via social media, demanding advance payments but failing to deliver.
- 4. Job Scams Advertisements for high-paying part-time jobs that require upfront fees or the sharing of bank account details.
- (2) Self-Protection Measures: If you suspect a scam, report it to the school immediately or call the Anti-Fraud Hotline at 165.
  - Do not trust unknown phone calls or messages. Always verify with the school or authorities before responding to suspicious requests. Avoid clicking on unknown links or sharing personal information.
